What are NameServers ?

Nameservers are part of DNS, which stands for “Domain Name System.”

it converts a domain name, such as “www.example.com,” to a machine-readable IP address, such as “22.231.113.64.” Most nameservers provided by hosts look something like **ns1.yourhostdomain.com**. You’ll normally be given two different nameservers. Setting up nameservers usually only takes a few seconds once you have the right information.

we are using Liquid Web servers.

The Liquid Web Name Servers (NS) are:

ns.liquidweb.com

ns1.liquidweb.com

Why we are change Name Servers? What is the purpose?:

Nameservers are provided by web hosts, and they’re key to your website being visible on the web. The most important **function of DNS** servers is the translation (resolution) of human-memorable domain names and hostnames into the corresponding numeric Internet Protocol (IP) addresses.

The second principal name space of the Internet which is used to identify and locate computer systems and resources on the Internet.

Prerequisites:


Process:

1. Sign into your **Namecheap account**

The Sign In option is available in the top hat of the page.

You can find login details for namecheap account in lastpass.

2. Find the **Nameservers** section and select **Custom** from the drop down menu.
